VINCENT DE PAUL (1581-1660) WAS A FRENCH PRIEST WHO IS CONSIDERED THE PATRON SAINT OF CHARITABLE SOCIETIES (CANONIZED 1737). HE FOUNDED THE CONFRATERNITIES (LADIES) OF CHARITY IN 1617, THE CONGREGATION OF THE MISSION (VINCENTIAN PRIESTS) IN 1625, AND THE DAUGHTERS OF CHARITY IN 1633. KNOWN FOR HIS CHARITY AND COMPASSION FOR THE POOR, VINCENT WAS RECOGNIZED IN THE FOUNDING OF THE SOCIETY THAT CARRIES HIS NAME.

THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL WAS FOUNDED IN 1833 IN PARIS, FRANCE, AND IN THE UNITED STATES IN 1845. TODAY MORE THAN 800,000 VINCENTIANS IN 150+ COUNTRIES SERVE THE POOR AND INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP'S SPIRITUALITY. NEARLY 100,000 U.S.A. MEMBERS PROVIDE HOME VISITS, FOOD, RENT AND UTILITIES ASSISTANCE, CLOTHING AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS, PHARMACIES, AND OTHER SERVICES TO OUR FRIENDS IN NEED.
