### Sacramento Diocesan Council Resolution No. 2015/16-02

### Establishment of a Vincentian Memorial Roll in the Jubilee Year of Mercy

**WHEREAS**, the Bishop of Sacramento, the Most Reverend Jaime Soto, has called upon Catholics in the Diocese of Sacramento, during this Jubilee Year of Mercy, as declared by Pope Francis, to study and live the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy, and

**WHEREAS**, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul charges us with the serious obligation, through regular practice at each meeting and at appropriate observances, to pray for our deceased members of the Vincentian Family, and

**WHEREAS**, our prayers for the deceased signify our Catholic creed concerning “the communion of saints” and the “resurrection of the dead” and affirm our core belief in the permanence of our friendship in Christ through our fellowship in the Society of St. Vincent de Paul,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Sacramento Diocesan Council, for itself and its districts and conferences, hereby does establish a perpetual roll of deceased Vincentians in memory of the lives of our Vincentian brothers and sisters so dedicated to charity and justice in the models of St. Vincent de Paul, St. Louse de Marillac, Blessed Frederic Ozanam, and Blessed Sister Rosalie Rendu.
